MOTION FOR CONSTRUCTIVE SERVICE BY ELECTRONIC PUBLICATION

KEN SKRIEN ("Plaintiff"), pro se, pursuant to Arkansas Rule 4(g) (4), files this Motion for Constructive Service by Electronic Publication, and states as follows:

Plaintiff has diligently attempted to serve Todd Matyjasik,
 Samantha Matyjasik, Abigail Johnson and Faith Johnson
 ("Defendants") using traditional manners, including Certified Mail
 (EXHIBITS G and H) and publication of Warning Order (EXHIBIT I).

- 2. Plaintiff has also used multiple methods of digital communications to ensure Defendants are aware of the action against them. Such methods include posting documents filed with the Court at a Wordpress website hosted at the domain ToddLivedHere.com ("Website") and advising Defendants of such through SMS, mail and electronic mail at addresses known or believed to be associated with Defendants.
- 3. Shortly after posting the Original Complaint at the Website on August 28, 2024, an email address known to be associated with Samatha Matyjasik subscribed to the site (EXHIBIT J). Verification of email is required before Plaintiff, in his role as webmaster, is notified of subscription.
- 4. Plaintiff believes other electronic methods were also successful in notifying Defendants of action against them, however cannot document such. Due to the two step signup procedure, Defendants subscription to the aforementioned site on August 31, 2024 clearly documents awareness of the Complaint against them.
- Continued postal delivery attempts to Defendants pursuant to traditional methods of service, will continue to fail. Defendants last known residential address, 1069 Highway 215 in Oark, AR remains vacant.

- 6. Certified Mail sent to Defendants at their last known residential address was returned undeliverable, with a forwarding address of PO Box 1 in Oark, AR. This PO Box is known by Plaintiff to be registered to the sister of Defendant Samantha Matyjasik, who resides at 1063 Highway 215 in Oark, AR. This property is Plaintiffs immediate neighbor, and shares the same driveway. As such Plaintiff is confident Defendants do not reside at this address and continued attempts using USPS Certified Mail with Restricted Delivery will fail.
- 7. Immediately prior to September 11, 2024 hearing
 Defendants left a message with the Johnson County Clerk of
 Courts which was read into the record by the Johnson County
 Sheriffs Office. According to this message, Defendant "lives two
 states away".
- 8. While Plaintiff disputes Defendants assertion that they found out about the Hearing the same morning, it is therefore highly unlikely that Defendant will see notifications in the Johnson County (AR) Graphic. Defendants unknown location thereby makes local print publication unproductive.
- Arkansas Rules of Civil Procedure 4 (g)(4) explicitly states that this Court may order service by any method reasonably calculated to apprise the defendant of the action.

WHEREFORE Plaintiff requests the Court order that all Pleadings and other actions pertaining to this matter be henceforth published at the Website, and that timely posting of such shall constitute sufficient proof of service.
